Indoor League

Indoor season is well underway with Multicolor league in full swing. Multicolor league will run through January 2018. WSAA State Championship will be held January 12-14 at multiple locations around the state and will culminate with the World Archery Championship February 9-11 in Las Vegas. It is too late to sign up for the league, but do welcome anyone to come join us. Blueface league will begin February 2 and run through March 30. We will continue to shoot on Tues and Friday evenings, running two line times on Tues at 5:00 and 7:00 pm and Friday at 7:00pm. Blueface format is 12 ends of 5 arrows with two practice ends at the beginning. Shooters are given 4 minutes to shoot the 5 arrows

from 20 yards. Arrows are scored 5, 4,3,2,1 with the goal of a perfect score of 300. There are several options to sign up for: WSAA mail-in league, KBH league, money, and teams. Indoor league is a great way to hone your shooting skills and endurance for outdoor season while staying warm inside. So come on in and join us and make some new friends.



Rain Forest Archers

KBH is home for the Rain Forest Archers. The Rain Forest Archers include a Junior Olympic Archery Development (JOAD) team consisting of archers from the ages of 7 through 20, and an Adult Archery Program (AAP) team for the more serious adult students above the age of 20. We also have an Explore Archery program for anyone ages 6 through 99 who just want to see what archery is all about. We are honored to have recently taught our oldest archer, who was 93 at the time of the lesson.

The Rain Forest Archers started with the JOAD program in January 2015. In August 2016, the AAP group was established. For such a new program, we are proud to have archers achieve first place in the following competitions:

The JOAD and AAP programs have a "Star Pin" that is awarded for scoring achievements. The highest level that can be awarded locally is 8 Stars. Above that level, the awards are given by USA Archery, and are recognized nationally. The Rain Forest Archery JOAD team of 19 archers has 4 members who have achieved the 8 Star Pin level and 5 who have achieved the 6 Star Pin level. The AAP team of 10 archers has one member with 7 Stars, and two with 6 Stars earned during their once a month Saturday official scoring sessions. KBH members are welcome to watch the JOAD and AAP archers shoot their best to achieve their next Star Pin and shoot for the gold!
