Deployment? No Worries!!

Just a reminder!

The KBH board of Directors have received numerous requests to offer a Military Discount to our archers. After lengthy discussion we have decided that the best approach for our Active Duty Military Members is to offer a **Suspension of Membership** for our Military Members on deployment.

This Suspension of Membership will be offered to any Military Member who meets the following criteria:

- *Membership at KBH shall be current.
- *Duration of Suspension of Membership shall be no less than 3 months.
- *Families of Military Member on deployment do not wish to use KBH during this Suspension.
- *Military Member shall notify the Membership VP by e-mail **prior to deployment** that they will be out of the area and wish for their membership to be suspended for the duration of deployment. No specific dates of deployment are required. After completion of deployment, it is up to the Military Member to notify the Membership VP that they have returned. Military Members must supply the name of the Command that has sent them on deployment.

NEW! Special Notice to all Active Duty Military Members - ask for a discount on our Safari, Spring Fling and Rendezvous shoots. Be prepared to show identification at the registration table.






Hunting VP Corner by Buz Runyon

A Symply Traditional Heritage

Measuring the speed of an arrow using Compare Arrow Drop

By comparing the arrow drop at two distances, you can get a fairly accurate measurement of your bow's speed in FPS.

- 1) Shoot a group of arrows from 20 yards using the pin set for that distance. Concentrate on good form and pin placement. The more accurate you are, the more precise your results will be.
- 2) Mark the center of the group as reference point with a marker.
- 3) Back up to 40 yards and shoot another group of arrows at the reference point you marked. However, use the same pin you used from 20 yards.
- 4) Mark the center of the group. Measure the distance (in inches) between the two groups. Compare the distance to the chart below:

Distance	FPS
28. 7	220
24.2	240
20.6	260
17.7	280
15.5	300
13.6	320
12.8	330
